### APPENDIX A

#### TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF MFS STUDENT CONFERENCE GRANTS TO ATTEND INTERNATIONAL/REGIONAL CONFERENCE

1. An applicant must be a **Malaysian Fisheries Society member** to qualify for travel support to attend international/regional conference.
2. An applicant should give a scientific **oral presentation** in the **aquaculture/fisheries related international/regional conference**.
3. A grant shall normally not be issued to the same member within 5 calendar years of his/her last grant.
4. **Closing dates** for applications is on **31<sup>st</sup> May 2019**.  
**Awardees** will be announced on **30<sup>th</sup> June 2019**
5. An applicant must indicate all other sources of funds that he has or intends to apply and its outcome.
6. The maximum amount of grant shall be **RM2000** for international conferences outside of Malaysia, and **RM750** for international conferences in Malaysia (subject to selection committee and MFS Council approval).
7. In the selection of travel grants, the selection committee shall take into account the quality of the paper to be presented in the conference.
8. The successful applicant shall **submit an extended abstract/written report** of the Conference to the MFS Council **not later than one month** of his/her return from the Conference.
9. The MFS Council reserves the right to publish the extended abstract/written report in FISHMAIL.
